Osteoporosis Clinical Research Study

The University of Wisconsin Osteoporosis Research Program is conducting a six month clinical research study assessing how fast positive bone effects are seen with BONIVA, an FDA-approved osteoporosis medication taken once-monthly.

If you.....

- *are a woman, 65 years of age or older*
- *have, or concerned that you may have, osteoporosis*
- *are not on treatment medication for osteoporosis
.....you may be eligible to participate*

The study includes:

- Bone density testing
- Physical exam
- Blood and urine testing
- Osteoporosis drug treatment or placebo

All study participants receive:

- Calcium and vitamin-D supplementation

All study procedures, testing, study medication and supplements are provided at no charge.
Study participants receive \$20 compensation at each completed clinic visit.
